



Through our people we have been able to achieve our aim of not making The Laurels just an excellent Care Home, but a Home-from-Home for everyone who moves in.





Where We Are and How to Find Us



From Askern, follow the A19 towards Selby, go past Askern Greyhound Stadium on your left and take your next left turn on to Norton Common Road (Signposted Norton), this road changes to Station Road the High Street. The Laurels can be found on the right just after the School Boy Public House.

From the A1, take the A639 junction and follow signs for Askern and Campsall on Woodfield Road, after about 1/4 of a mile veer left on to White Ley Road, follow for about 1 mile then turn right onto Norton and Kirk Smeaton Road, stay on the road for about 2 miles and The Laurels is on the left just before the School Boy Public House.
